Many of you have probably received something in the mail in regards to renewing your outdoors card. You can do this online at the link mentioned below or we can renew them for you at the camp. You must renew it in order to purchase a fishing license from us. You can also purchase your fishing license online, but we will still be selling these at the camp. If you do not have an outdoors card because you haven't fished in Canada for the past three years, we will also be able to sell you one of these.

If your non-Canadian resident Outdoors Card is lost, stolen or destroyed you should call the Outdoors Card Centre as soon as possible at 1-800-387-7011 to arrange for a replacement.
